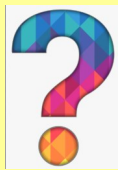

How do people express commitment to Christianity in different ways?

Vocabulary

	<b>Belonging</b>	Belonging means to be part of a group or community that is important to you.
	<b>Commitment</b>	Being dedicated to a pledge or cause or to promise to do something.
	<b>Faith</b>	A belief in God or in the doctrines or teachings of religion .
	<b>Rite of Passage</b>	A ritual, event, or experience that marks or constitutes a major milestone or change in a person's life.
	<b>Christianity</b>	The religion derived from Jesus Christ, based on the Bible as sacred scripture .
	<b>Baptism</b>	A Christian sacrament marked by ritual use of water and admitting the recipient to the Christian community.
	<b>Judaism</b>	The religion of the Jews, based on the Old Testament and the Talmud.
	<b>Bar Mitzvah</b>	A Jewish boy who reaches his 13th birthday and attains the age of religious duty and responsibility.
	<b>Bat Mitzvah</b>	Jewish girl who at 12 or more years of age assumes religious responsibilities.
