

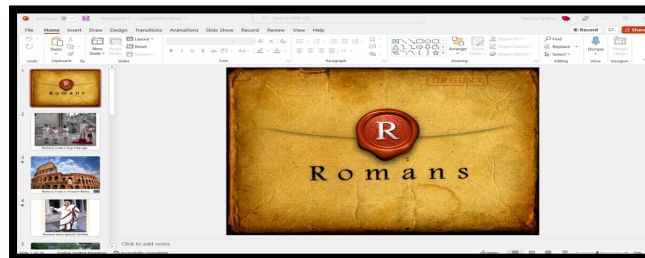
## Vocabulary

<b>presentation</b>	a piece of work used to get our ideas across to an audience
<b>slide</b>	a single page of our presentation
<b>slide-show</b>	several pages of a presentation, running one after the other
<b>transition</b>	a visual affect used when moving from one slide to another
<b>animation</b>	making images or text move on
<b>hyperlink</b>	a tool which enables you to jump to a different page on your presentation (or to a website)
<b>retrieve</b>	finding a saved piece of work
<b>cursor</b>	a moveable indicator on your screen, controlled by the mousepad

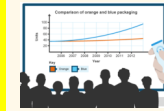

## Key Facts



PowerPoint is one type of presentation software. Presentation software is used to create slideshows which are used to get a message across to an audience.

Using hyperlinks to link pages means that the presenter can move between the pages they need more easily. It's also useful for quizzes.



Transition and animation tools allow the presenter to draw attention and add interest to important information

PowerPoint is not the only presentation software. Others include Google Slides, Canva and Keynote.
