


Portrait - A portrait is a painting or a photograph of a person's face and its expression. traits tell us something about that person, their sto-



**Complementary** - Complementary colors are opposite colors on the standard color wheel. Using complementary colors creates contrast in an image that is pleasing to the eye. For example, blue and orange.



**Texture** - describes the way colour, line and shape are used to create a three-dimensional effect.
