

## Knowledge Organiser Rivers: How are rivers formed?

Vocabulary		cabulary
	Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to the ground or condenses on the ground.
	Evaporation	The process of turning liquid into vapour.
	Condensation	Water which collects as droplets on a cold surface when humid air is in contact with it.
	Upper course	Features of the upper course of a river include: steep-sided V shaped valleys, rapids, waterfalls and gorges.
	Middle course	Features of the middle course of a river include: wider, shallower valleys,
	Lower course	Features of the lower course of a river include: wide flat-bottomed valleys, flood plains and deltas.
	Tributary	A river or stream flowing into a larger river.
	Mouth	A river flowing into a larger body of water e.g. lake, sea or ocean.
	Counties	A specific named area of a country.
