Key Vocabulary

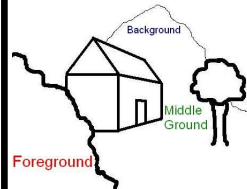
Landscape: Landscape, in art means a depiction of a natural scene such as, mountains, rivers, beaches, forests, etc...



Perspective: The representation of three-dimensional objects or spaces in two dimensional artworks.



Watercolours: Water-soluble paint that has transparent or translucent properties. Watercolors can be "soft" or "light" because the pigments in watercolors are often not as bright as acrylics or oil paints.



Foreground: The area closest to the viewer, which will almost always be in the lower section of your picture. This area will contain the most detail.

Background: The parts of a scene that are behind a main figure, object or subject in a painting, photograph, or other medium.
