

Vocabulary

slide	a single page in a presentation
transition	a visual effect used when moving from one slide to the next
hyperlink	(often referred to as a 'link') a tool which connects to a webpage by clicking on an image or text
embedded link	a link that provides a visual element to a presentation (e.g. an image or video)
bullet point	a way of presenting information in small chunks that are easier to read and more visually pleasing
animation	special visual effects that can be added to text, shapes and images to make them move or change
notes	details recorded in PowerPoint to support presenter
theme	a combined set of colours, fonts and effects that can be used in a presentation

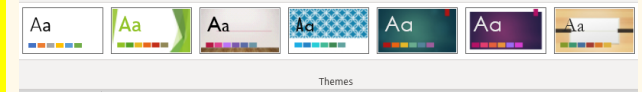

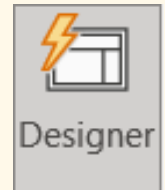
Key Facts

PowerPoint is one type of presentation software. It can be used to create **slideshows** to present information to an **audience**.



It is important to think carefully about the topic of a presentation when selecting a **theme**. You can personalise your **presentation** by **formatting** backgrounds or editing colours and fonts.

You can find more options in the **designer** pane for instant slide makeovers.



Notes can be used when creating a presentation to record information that the presenter will say to their **audience** rather than display on screen. Using this feature can help keep **slides** simple and easy to read as well as improving the delivery of a presentation.
