Key Vocabulary



Observational-Observational drawing is **drawing what you see**. It's as simple and as complicated as that. It can be a flower, a person, a still life, a landscape, or anything, really. But it's drawing what you see in front of you as realistically and as true to life as possible.



Drawing-a picture or diagram made with a pencil, pen, or crayon rather than paint



Shape-spaces that are created when a line reconnects with itself. These can be wobbly and abstract or precise, like a triangle or square.



Continuous line-A continuous line drawing is all about keeping your pen touching the paper - no exceptions! It doesn't matter if it makes the drawing look scribbly or messy - that's part of the fun!



Wire-metal drawn out into the form of a thin flexible thread or rod



Sculpture-the art of making two- or threedimensional representative or abstract forms. Sculptures can be made from any materials such as, stone, wood, metals, paper, material
