How can children take part in the Challenge?

The Summer Reading Challenge is a flexible programme that is designed for all levels of ability.

At the library

A child will visit their local library and sign up the Challenge for free. They will need to be a library member. Remember, it is free to join your local library. They receive their Marvellous Makers core pack folder.

They set a personal reading goal for the summer.

Borrow and read books, e-books and audiobooks of their choice.

- They can read anything they like: fiction, fact books, poetry, joke books, picture books, graphic novels, audiobooks...

Collect special stickers from the library each time they finish a book.

Receive a certificate and medal for taking part, or for reaching their Challenge goal.

In addition, libraries offer a wide variety of events and activities for families to enjoy throughout the summer.

Online

Alternatively, children can participate in the Challenge online.

Sign up at summerreadingchallenge.org.uk

Set a personal reading goal for the summer.

Receive book recommendations and tips for accessing books for free at home.

You can download e-books as a library member for free.

Each time they finish a book, the child adds it to their online profile and leaves a review.

They unlock digital badges and online rewards along the way.

Unlock a certificate for reaching their Challenge goal.

Children can also play games, enter competitions, share book recommendations and more on our free, safe, moderated platform.

The Summer Reading Challenge is open to all children aged 5-11.

There is also a mini challenge for under 5's.

The 2024 Challenge launches on Saturday 6th July in Norfolk Libraries.
