
#### WHOLE SCHOOL TRIP TO THE CATHEDRAL

How can children take part in the Challenge?

The Summer Reading Challenge is a flexible programme that is designed for all levels of ability.

#### At the library

A child will visit their local library and sign up the Challenge for free. They will need to be a library member. Remember, it is free to join your local library. They receive their Marvellous Makers core pack folder.

They set a personal reading goal for the summer.

Borrow and read books, e-books and audiobooks of their choice.

 They can read anything they like: fiction, fact books, poetry, joke books, picture books, graphic novels, audiobooks...

Collect special stickers from the library each time they finish a book. Receive a certificate and medal for taking part, or for reaching their Challenge goal.

In addition, libraries offer a wide variety of events and activities for families to enjoy throughout the summer.

#### **Online**

Alternatively, children can participate in the Challenge online.

Sign up at summerreadingchallenge.org.uk

Set a personal reading goal for the summer.

Receive book recommendations and tips for accessing books for free at home.

You can download e-books as a library member for free.

Each time they finish a book, the child adds it to their online profile and leaves a review. They unlock digital badges and online rewards along the way.

Unlock a certificate for reaching their Challenge goal.

Children can also play games, enter competitions, share book recommendations and more on our free, safe, moderated platform.
